

The Award has been developed for the purposes of setting and maintaining excellent standards in the management consulting profession, and recognises consistent and high levels of professional development and achievement, benchmarked against a competency framework.

## THE UNDERLYING PRINCIPLES OF THE COMPETENCY FRAMEWORK

The competency framework covers the four key components of the profession: values, ethics & behaviours; the profession itself; clients and individual consultants.

 Effectively leads and manages solutions, assignments and or work streams teams and resources.


