
THE IMPACT of MANAGEMENT APPRENTICES

A recent CMI Apprenticeship survey of our recent apprenticeship research of our Management Apprentices who are on journey or have completed their apprenticeship:



9 out of 10

of our apprentices felt they had made a **positive contribution to their business** as a result of completing their apprenticeship



of current apprentices reported **confidence in their ability** to do their job more effectively



8 out of 10

of apprentices said completing their apprenticeship had given them **better** career prospects



63%

of those that have completed management apprentices reported an increase in their productivity as a result of their management apprenticeship training

Nearly all completed apprentices (96%) said the management apprenticeship had helped them develop the skills they needed to be more productive at work, with communication and influencing (95%); managing themselves (94%); and developing people and capabilities (93%) topping the 'skills-gained' charts.

HOW MUCH COULD I RECIEVE?

Up to £4000

per new apprentice that you take on!

The incentive payment is in addition to the £1,000 employers already receive for hiring an apprentice:

- Aged 16 to 18 years old
- Under 25 with an education, health and care plan or who has been in the care of their local authority

APPRENTICES WHO JOINED YOUR ORGANISATION BEFORE 1 APRIL 2021

For **new apprentices** who joined your organisation between 1 August 2020 and 31 March 2021 aged:

- 16 to 24, employers will receive £2,000
- 25 and over, employers will receive £1,500

You must apply for these apprentices before 31 May 2021.

APPRENTICES WHO JOINED YOUR ORGANISATION FROM 1 APRIL 2021

Employers will receive £3,000 for **new apprentices** of any age who join their organisation from 1 April 2021 to 30 September 2021.

You can apply for incentive payments for these apprentices from 1 June 2021 to 30 November 2021.

WHAT DO I USE IT FOR?

The payment is not linked to the apprenticeship levy funds. You can spend it on anything to support your organisation's costs in taking on that apprentice e.g travel, salary, special equipment. You do not have to pay it back.

HOW DO I CLAIM IT?

You can apply for the incentive payment after you add new apprentices to your apprenticeship service account.

You must set up an apprenticeship service account to apply through the Digital Apprenticeship Service (DAS).



USING THE DIGITAL APPRENTICESHIP SERVICE (DAS)

If you are a Levy paying employer you will already use this to manage your apprenticeships.

If you are a Non-Levy paying employers, you will also have to claim the incentives via the DAS by creating a DAS account and providing relevant information for the apprentice, including the apprentice's date of birth, a copy of the apprenticeship agreement, a copy of the apprentice's employment contract including their start date and confirmation they were a new employee.
