CMI's 2024 STUDENT OF THE YEAR

Nominations for our CMI's 2024 Awards of Excellence are now open. Use this document to bring your submission information together, you can then submit this information using the online nomination form.

AWARD DESCRIPTION

Students are the managers and leaders of tomorrow. Instilled with an understanding of the value of management and leadership, they are on the path to inspiring and engaging the future workforce. The CMI Outstanding Student of the Year award recognises individuals who are already exceptional learners and are destined to make an impact as future leaders.

WHY ENTER THIS AWARD?

Even being shortlisted for this award will mark you out as a potential future leader. Nominees and the ultimate winner will be associated with the best qualities of management and leadership. You'll join a mutually supportive group of great students, apprentices and managers; be celebrated throughout the year across CMI channels; and have the opportunity to share insights and experiences with the wider management community. Nominees can be at any stage of their career to enter the Award as long as they meet the eligibility criteria below.

KEY CRITERIA

Nominees should demonstrate: outstanding academic achievement; strong progression on their programme; commitment to personal and professional development; impactful management and leadership capabilities. And you should be actively participating with CMI and its wider membership community.

ELIGIBILITY

- 1. To be eligible to submit a nomination for the CMI Outstanding Student of the Year, the nominating institution/organisation must be approved by CMI to deliver a CMI or CMI-accredited qualification or apprenticeship ("a CMI Partner") at any time between 1st May 2023 to 1st May 2024.
- 2. Nominees must:
 - a. Be, or have been, undertaking a CMI qualification, dual accredited qualification and/or apprenticeship linked to the Management and Leadership Apprenticeship Standards.; and
 - b. Be, or have been, enrolled at a CMI Partner at any time between 1 May 2023 and 1 May 2024.

- 3. Students may not nominate themselves.
- 4. Only one student, per cohort, per CMI-accredited course can be nominated by a CMI Partner each year.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

- 1. Each nominee will automatically be categorised by region.
- 2. A regional winner will be chosen from all nominations made in the appropriate region.
- 3. All Regional winners will be longlisted for the overall award and a shortlist of three will be announced in August 2024.
- 4. The winner of the overall award will be selected by the CMI judges panel from the shortlisted entries. Only one overall winner will be awarded.
- 5. The overall winner of the CMI Outstanding Student of the Year will be selected from the shortlist. The overall winner of the CMI Outstanding Student of the Year will receive a trophy and certificate. These will be presented at an awards ceremony in Autumn 2024.
- 6. The winners of each regional award and the overall award agree to work together with CMI to jointly promote the CMI Partner Awards and the activities of both the individual and the CMI.

- Evidence of progression on the programme (links, testimonials or related documents can be included as separate files)
- How the nominee shows commitment to personal and professional development
- How they're applying what they've learned in their course
- How they're demonstrating management or leadership capabilities, and making a positive impact on their employer, peers or institution
- How the nominee's activity, behaviour, skillsets showing alignment with CMI's mission, vision and values (see notes above)
